

Hello. You really, really need to hire Tim as your DJ for the wedding. He is worth every penny. At first, my husband was reluctant to hire Tim b/c he was out of our price range. But after a little convincing from me, he gave in and let me have my way. The week before our BIG day we ended up having another meeting with Tim at his house and my husband walked out of that meeting saying to me that he was really glad we hired Tim. Tim is extremely professional, he keeps in contact with you almost immediately after you email or call him. Tim is not only a DJ but acts as a wedding coordinator organizing the time line of the wedding events (which is extremely important!), and making sure everyone (all of your vendors) are on the same page as you are, so you don't miss those important photo ops or video moments.

Tim plays the music that you want to hear and has been doing this long enough where he knows what people want to hear without playing the typical cheesy wedding music. I was very impressed that Tim only played music requests by guests with my approval, which I thought was really cool b/c again you are in control. You are in charge of the wedding but Tim is essentially the consigieri, the counselor, the person that makes things happen while listening to your needs and wants. Tim played a wide variety of music at my wedding which appealed to all age groups and races. My dance floor was never empty so my guests obviously liked the music played by Tim.

I am telling you this honestly, you need to make the investment and hire Tim. You will not feel like you wasted your money. Just to let you know, I mentioned to my videographer who my DJ was and she told me that she has worked with him before and that she thinks he is the best DJ. Prior to hiring Tim, I saw him work at my girlfriend's wedding. At that wedding I knew I wanted Tim for my own b/c I had an absolute blast at my girlfriend's wedding as well as my own. I hope this helps and best of luck. Planning a wedding can be stressful but you need to feel confident with the choices you make, and trust that your vendors, like Tim, will do the best job possible for you. I promise you, you will not be disappointed with Tim.
